Activities 2009-2010

- 1. With the help of 30 voluntary reviewers, completed the 3rd Edition of the Wellstart International Lactation Management Self-Study Module Level 1.
- 2. Uploaded this tool to the Wellstart web site for down-loading and printing without charge.
- 3. Printed 1000 copies of this tool for those who prefer a printed copy. Have mailed out 975 copies also without charge.
- 4. A volunteer bilingual team has translated (and back translated) the Self-Study Modules into Spanish. It is currently undergoing final review for uploading onto the Wellstart web site and will very soon be available.

Activities 2009-2010 (continued)

- 5. The Self-Study Modules have also been translated into Indonesian and are now available in printed version (courtesy of the Indonesian Perinatal Society)
- 6. Developed an on-line "final exam" for the Modules. Anyone who gets a score of 80% or more correct answers will receive an immediate on-line, printable Certificate of Completion of the Self-Study Modules. This can be used by faculty or hospitals as confirmation of 3 or more hours of basic knowledge of BF management.
- 7. Wellstart International is a founding member of the US BC and participates in many activities of that national committee (health professional competencies, exclusive breastmilk feedingtool kit for hospitals to use in preparation for Joint commission review.
