Title	"Infant and Young Child Feeding Counseling Specialist"
Aim	To prepare health care providers with knowledge and appropriate counseling skills in infant and young child feeding to manage IYCF Counseling Centre.
Interest and commitment	Protecting, promoting and supporting breastfeeding and complementary feeding. Help for solving mother's problems
Who can do it	Pediatrician / Oby & Gynae and child doctors working in maternity and pediatrics hospitals, Nutrition Graduates, Senior nursing professional in Oby / Gynae.
Duration of training (7days)	7 days (51 Hours) including 5 X 2 hrs clinical practice in hospital.
Competence after receiving training	 Able to: Initiate setting up a infant and young child feeding counseling center Provide referral level support for problem solving at hospital Provide individual counselling on breastfeeding, complementary feeding HIV and Infant Feeding Taking lectures for college, school, NGOs and public on IYCF. Monitor IYCF, programme
Future potential	Can become National Trainer after undergoing 13 days training in IYCF.
Number of trainers needed	4 National Trainers to train 24 participants
