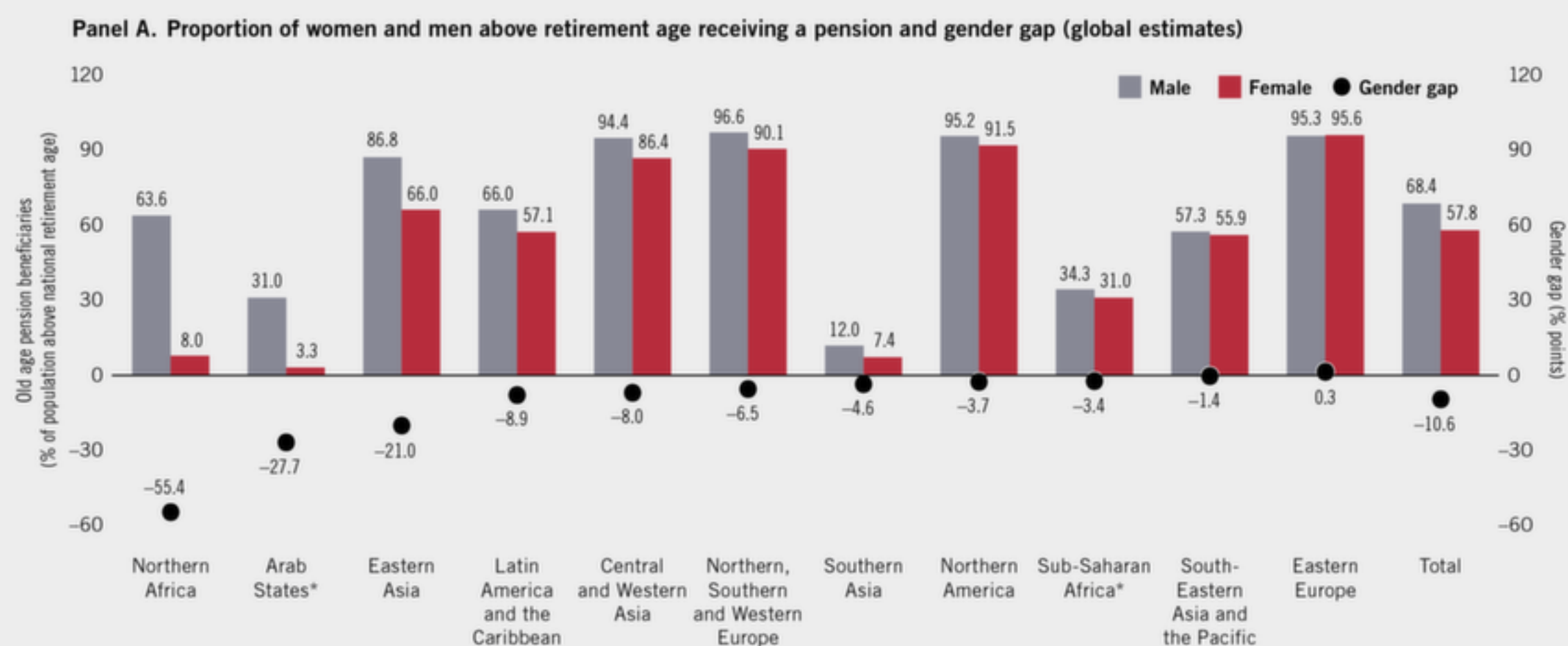
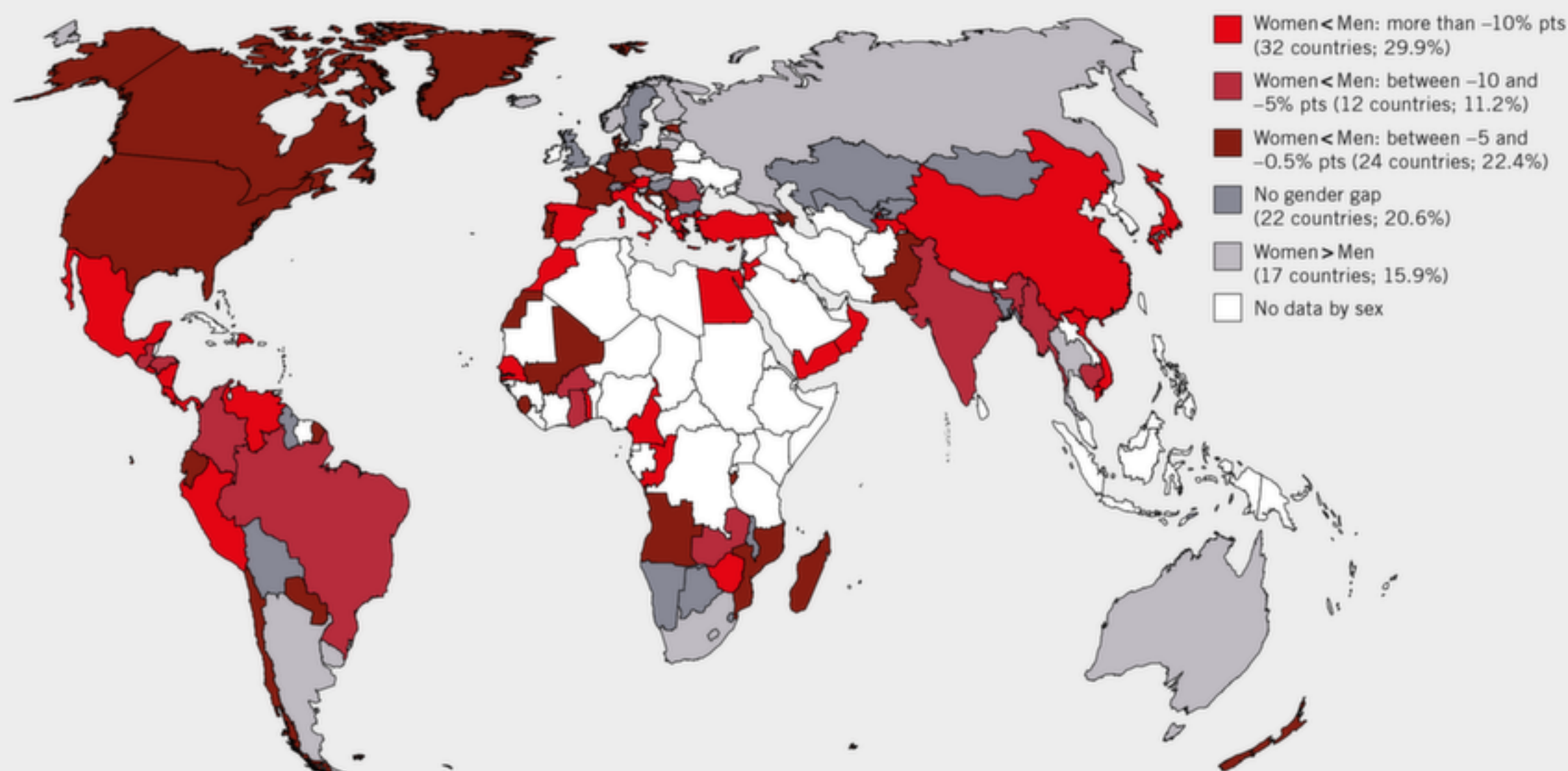


Figure 22 Actual gender gap in pension beneficiaries, 107 countries (latest year available)

This second indicator of coverage is measured as the proportion of the population above the statutory pensionable age receiving an old age or survivor's pension. In panel A, global estimates based on 107 countries representing 83 per cent of total population above national retirement age, weighted by population above national retirement age. The asterisk for the Arab States and sub-Saharan Africa regions means that these averages are not representative, as they are based on a limited number of countries (less than 50 per cent of the population above national retirement age is represented). In panel B, "no gender gap" is defined as a percentage points difference of -0.5 to +0.5 and "women>men" as a percentage points difference of 0.5 or more.
